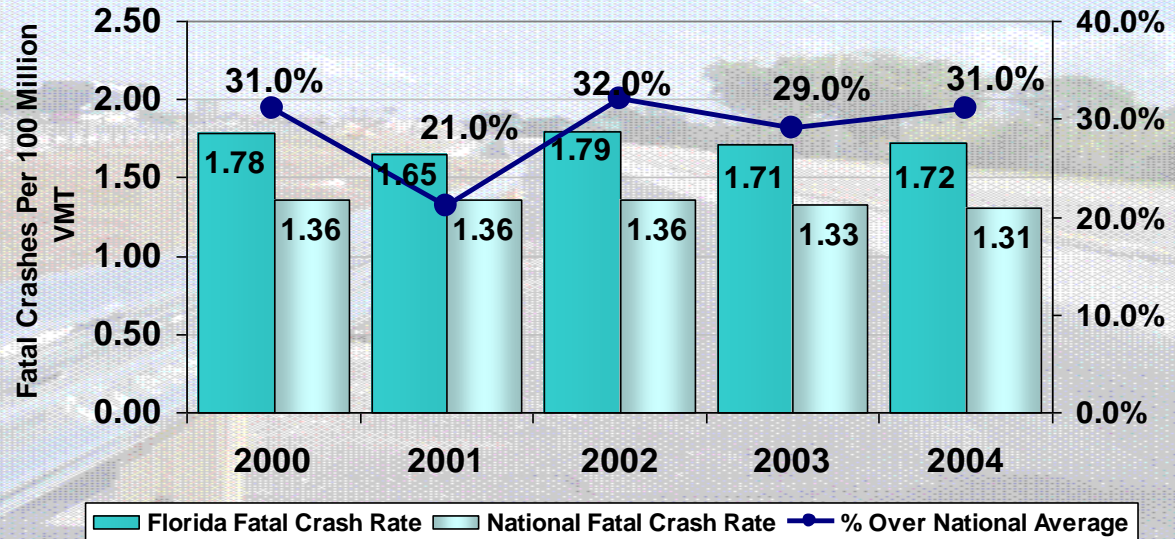

(Objective: Within 20% of National Rate)

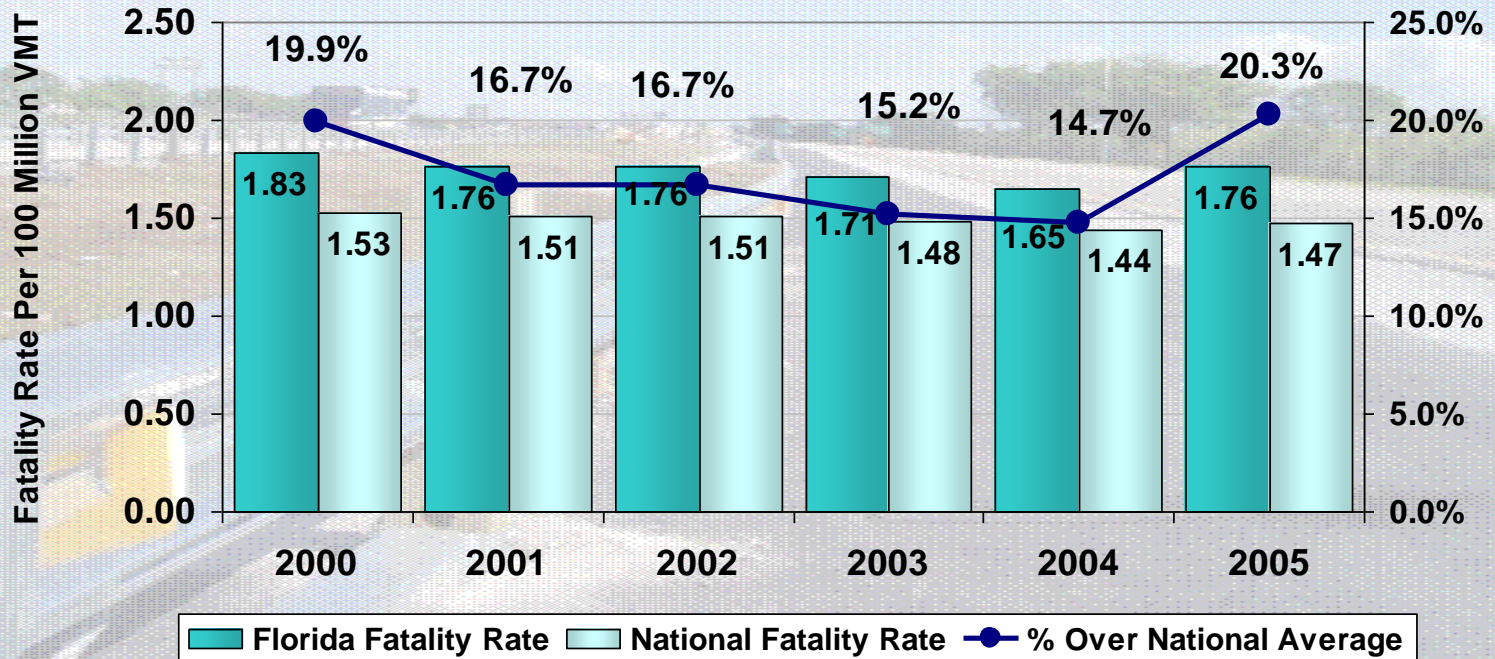

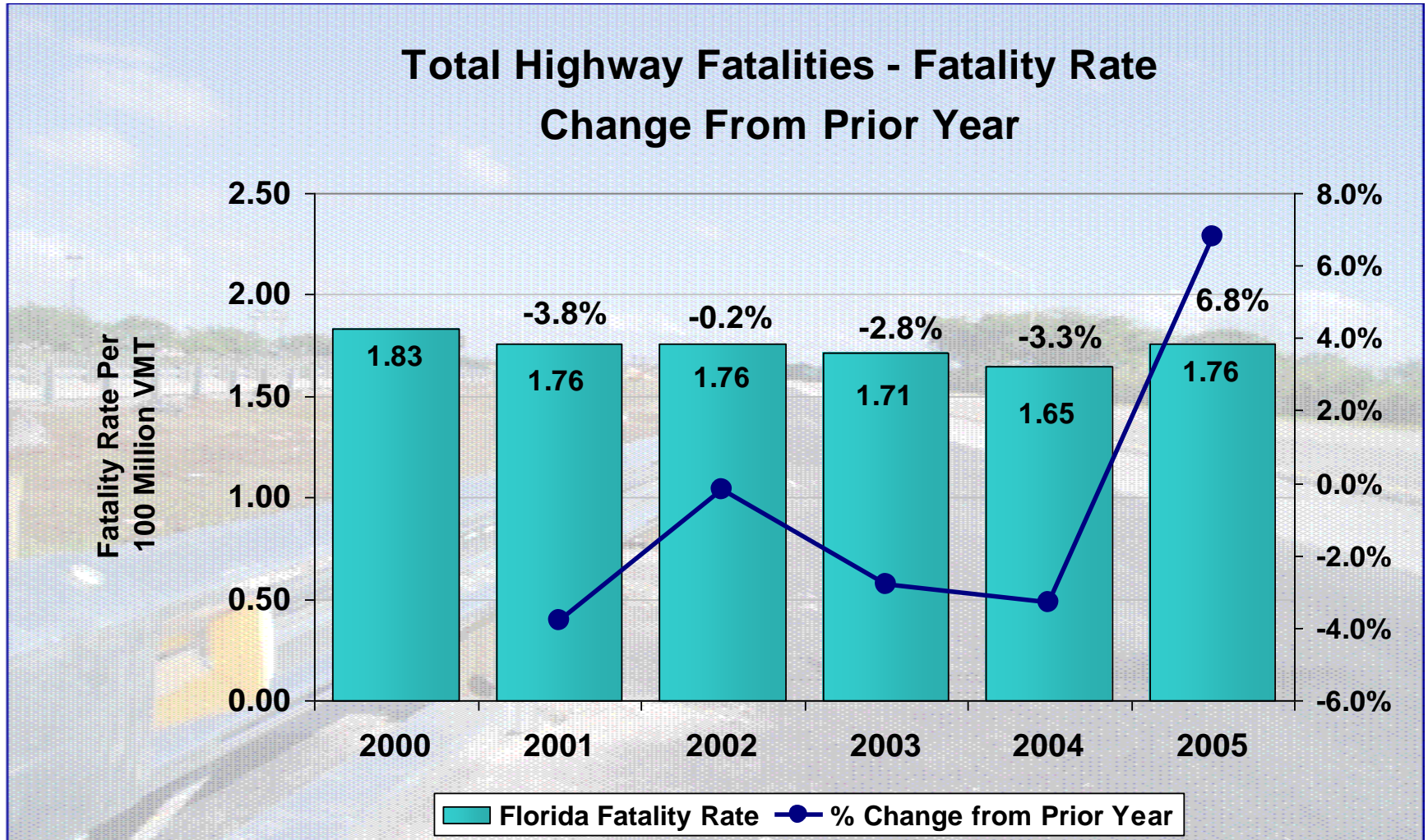
Total Highway Fatalities Florida Rate Compared to National Rate (Objective: within 5% of National Rate)

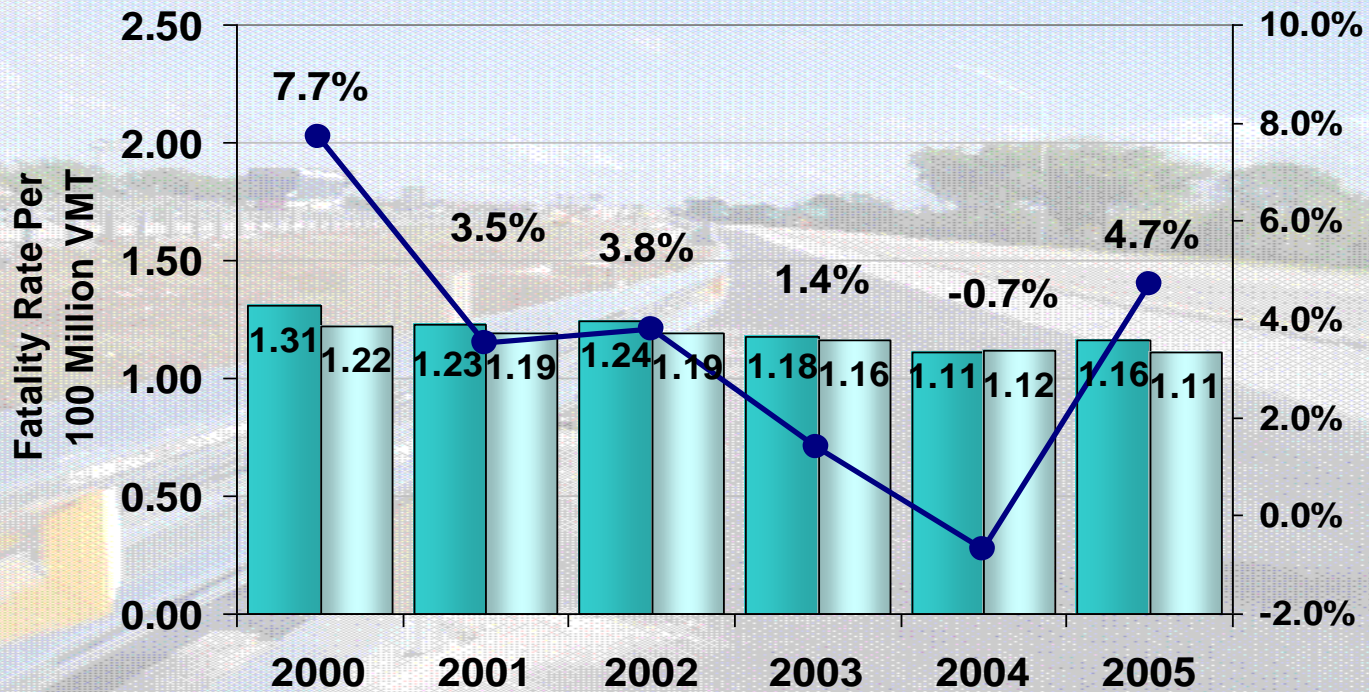

(Objective: 10% below National Rate)

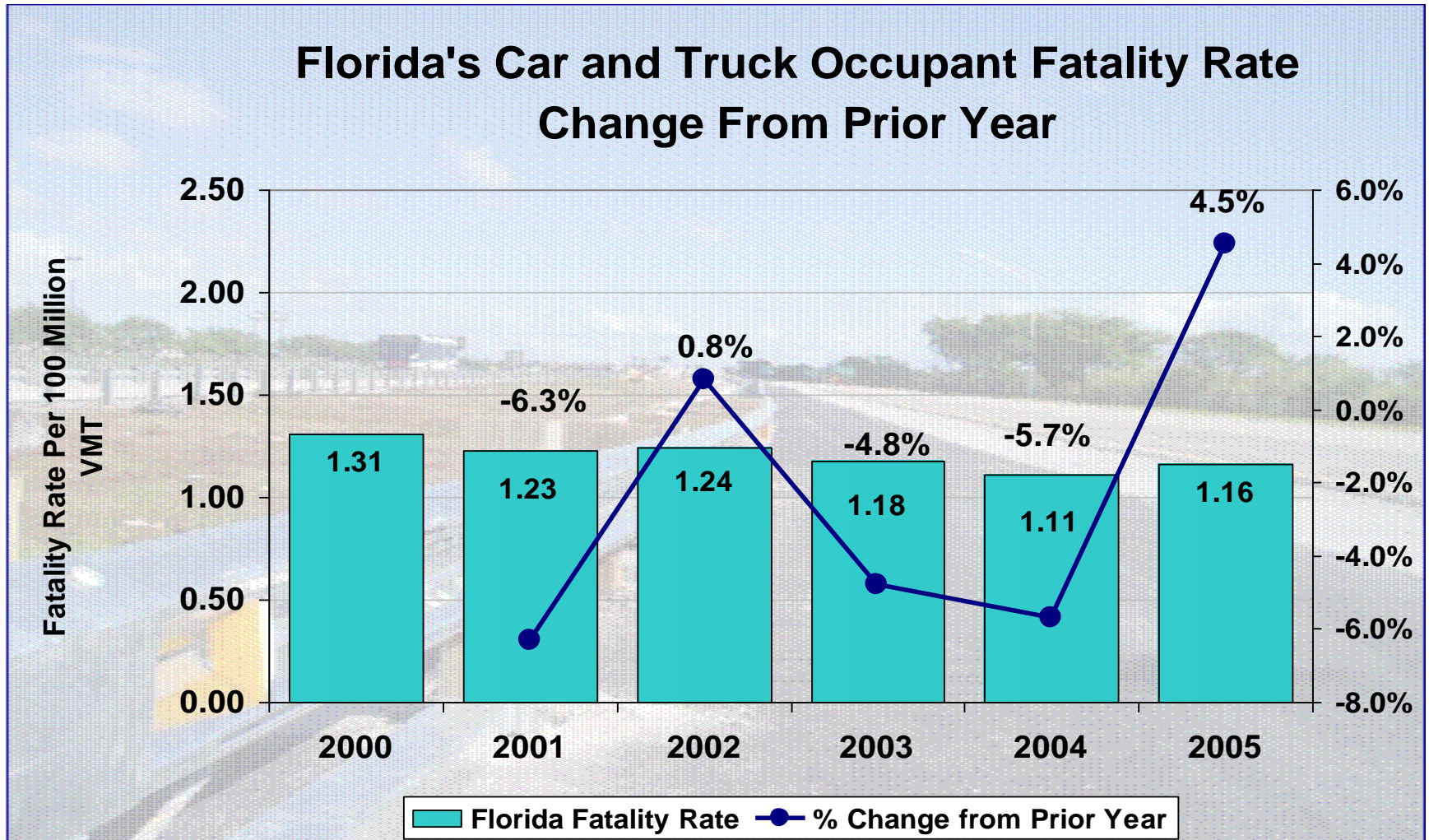


Legend: Florida Fatality Rate (teal bar), National Fatality Rate (light blue bar), % Over National Average (blue line with dots)

Florida's Car and Truck Occupant Fatality Rate Change From Prior Year

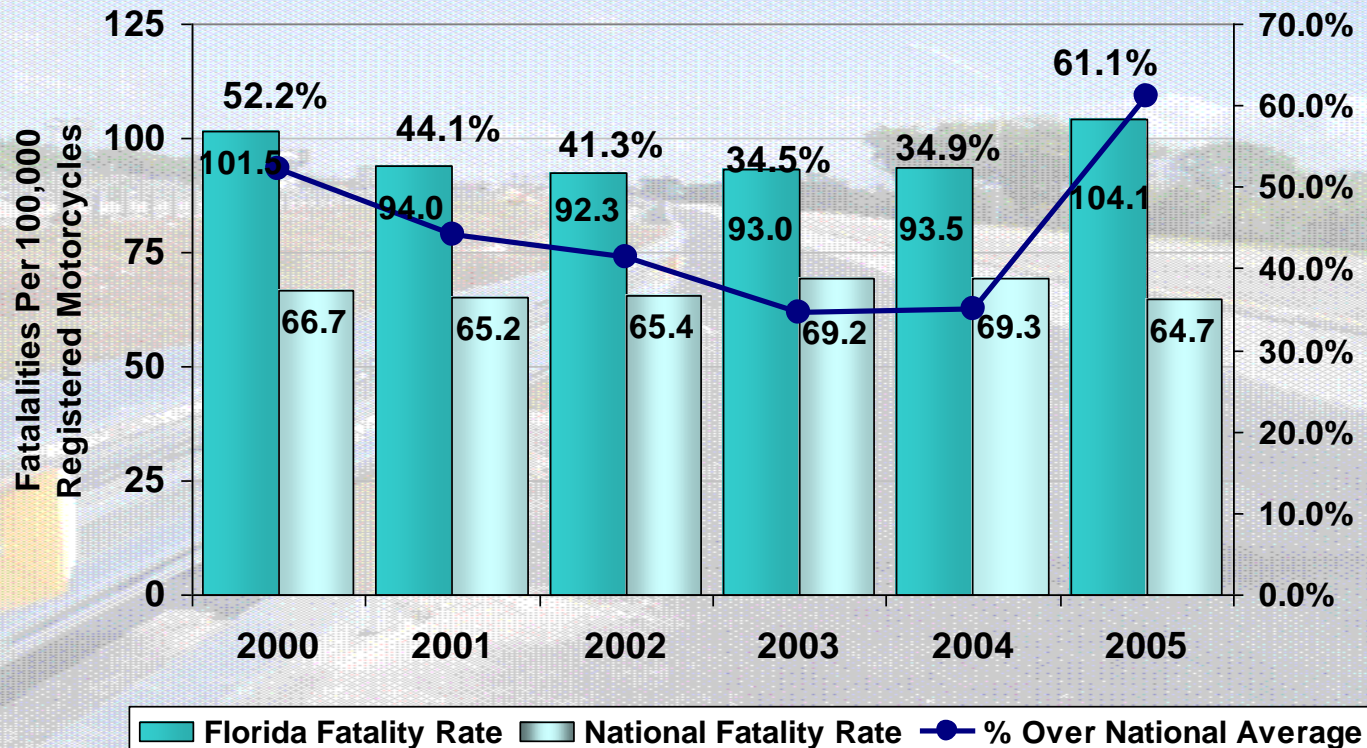

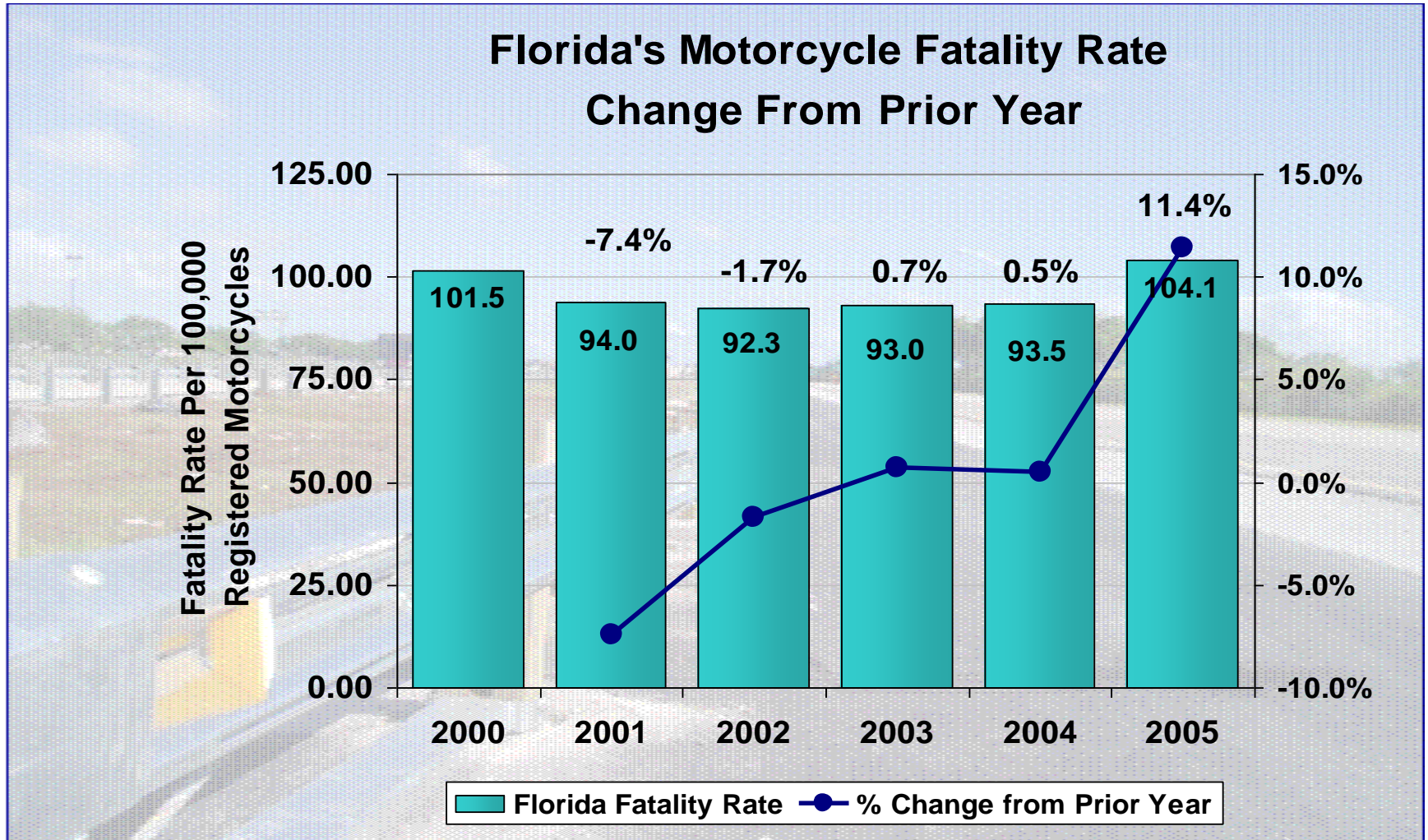
Florida Motorcyclist Fatalities Per 100,000 Registered Motorcycles - National and State Highway System

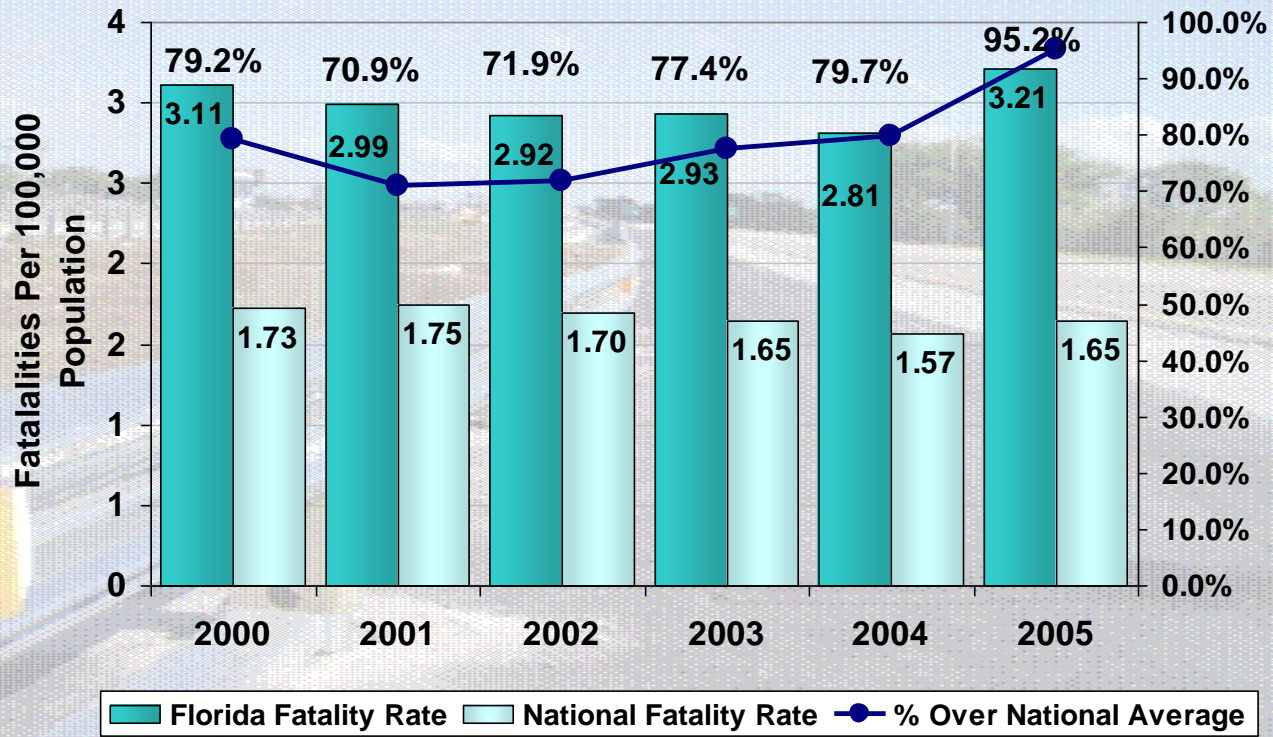

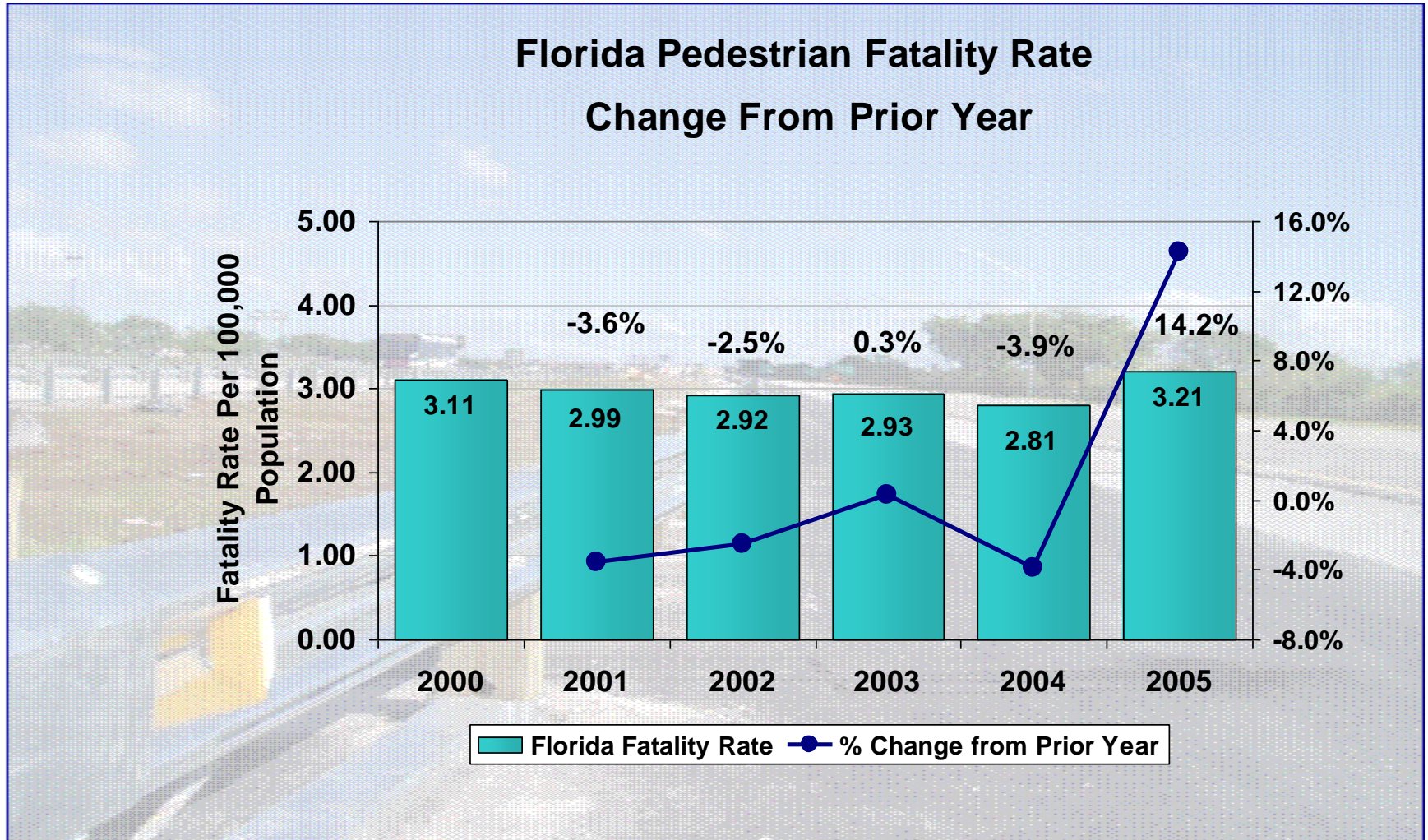
Florida Pedestrian Fatalities Per 100,000 Population National and State Highway System

(Objective: Within 20% of National Rate)





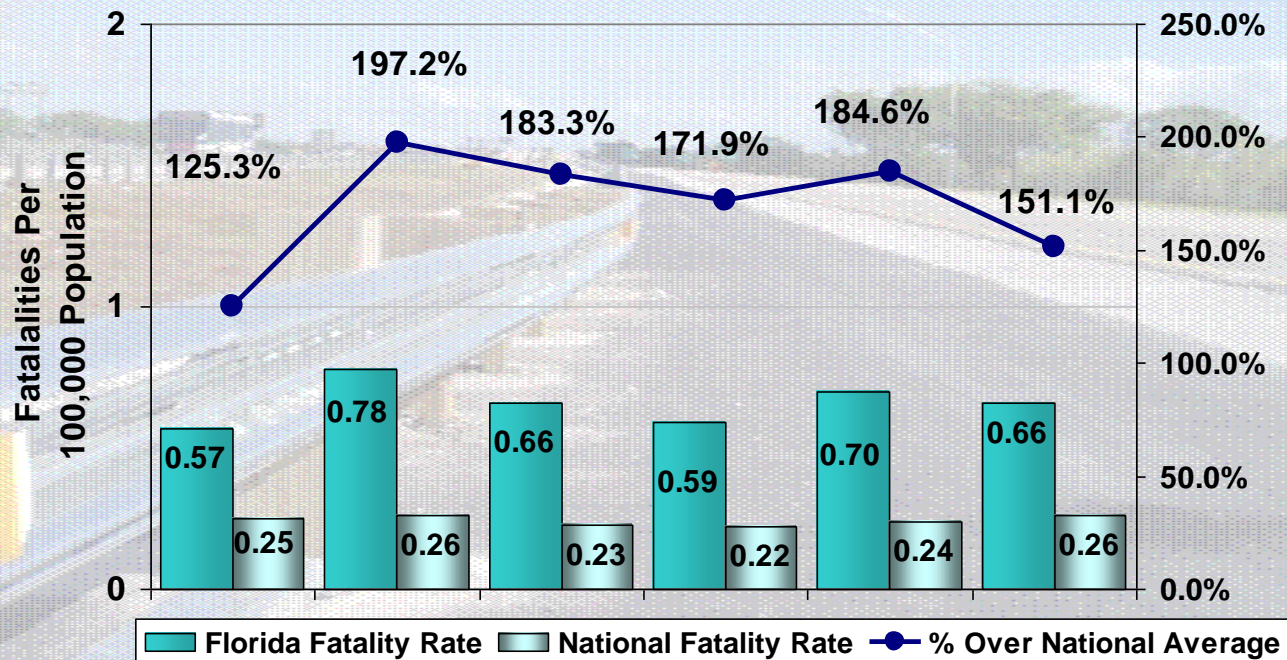

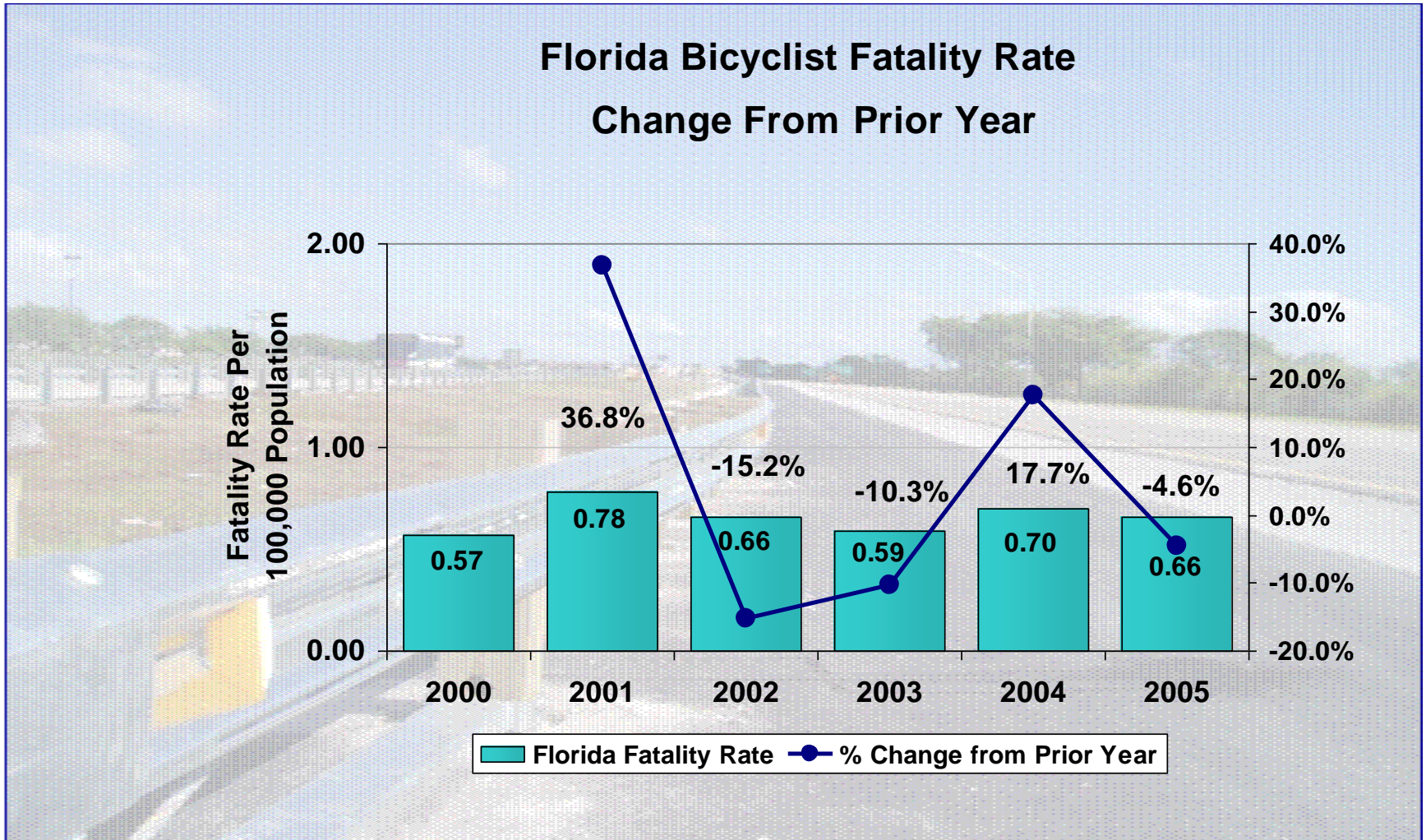

(Objective: Within 20% of National Rate)





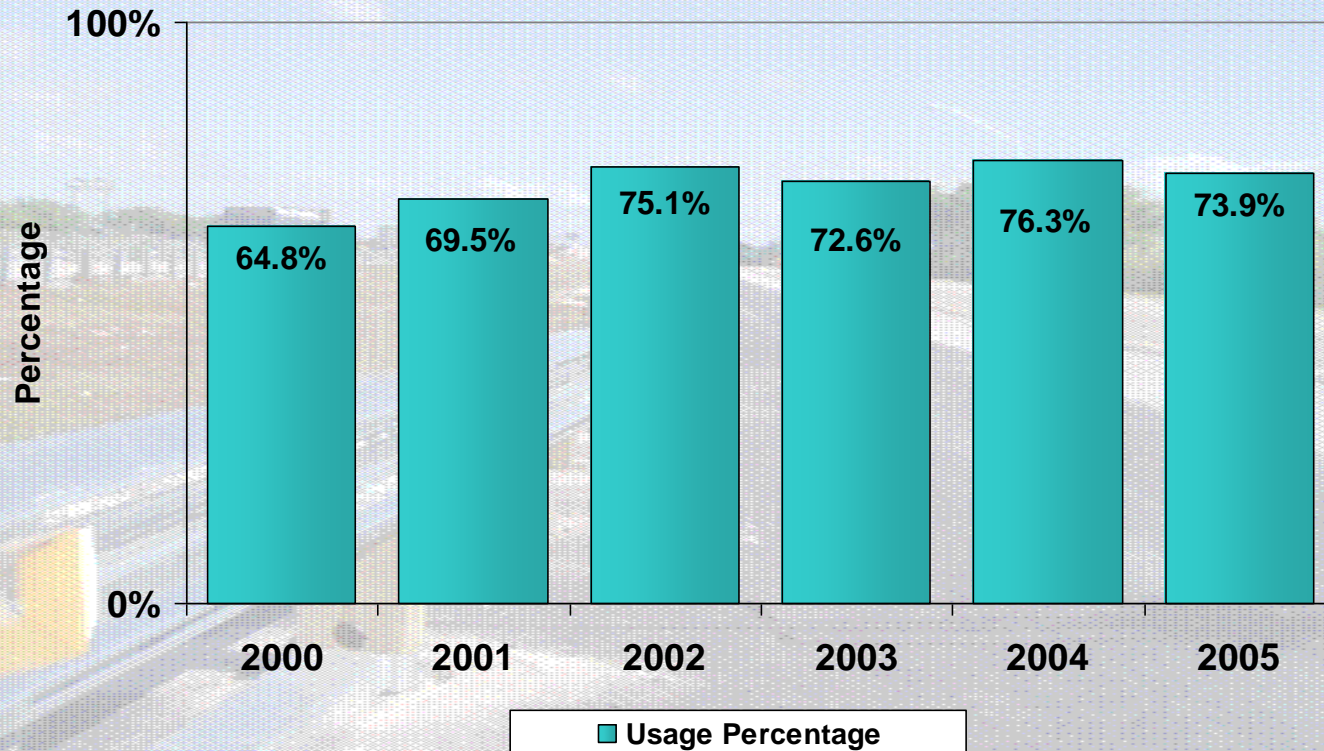

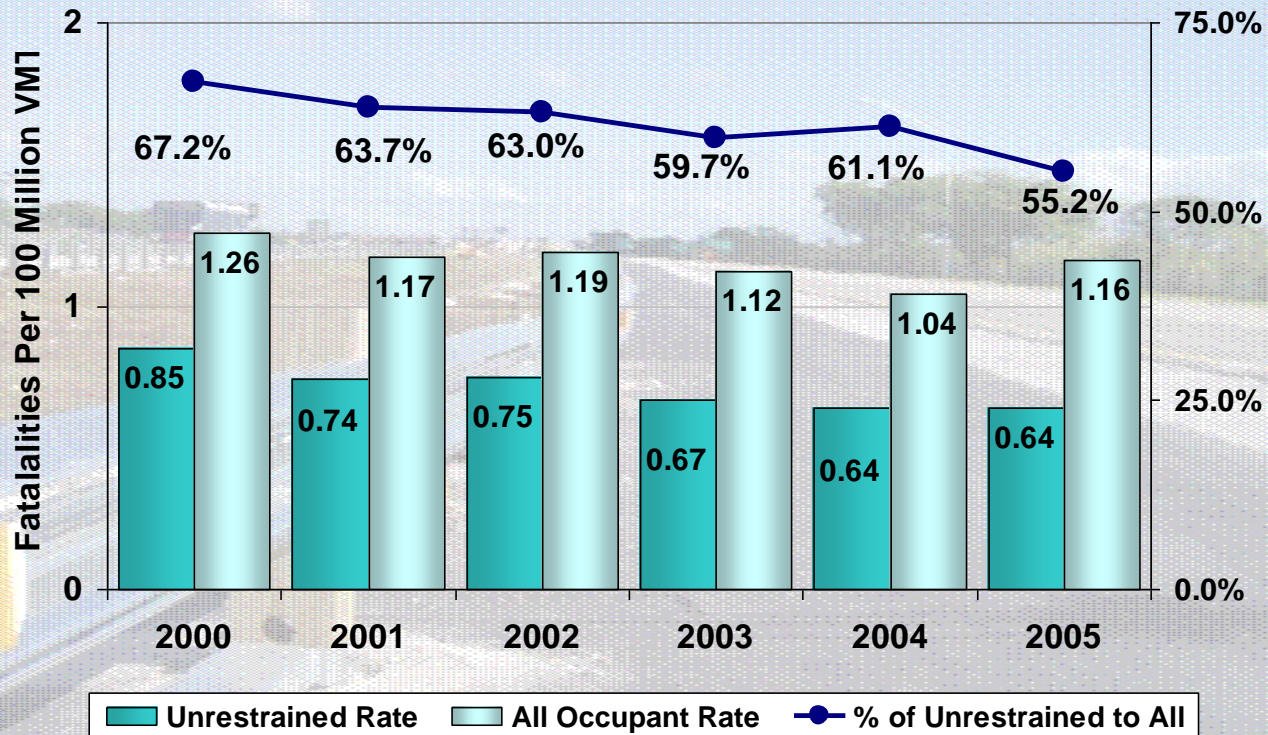
Florida Occupant Protection Usage Percentage

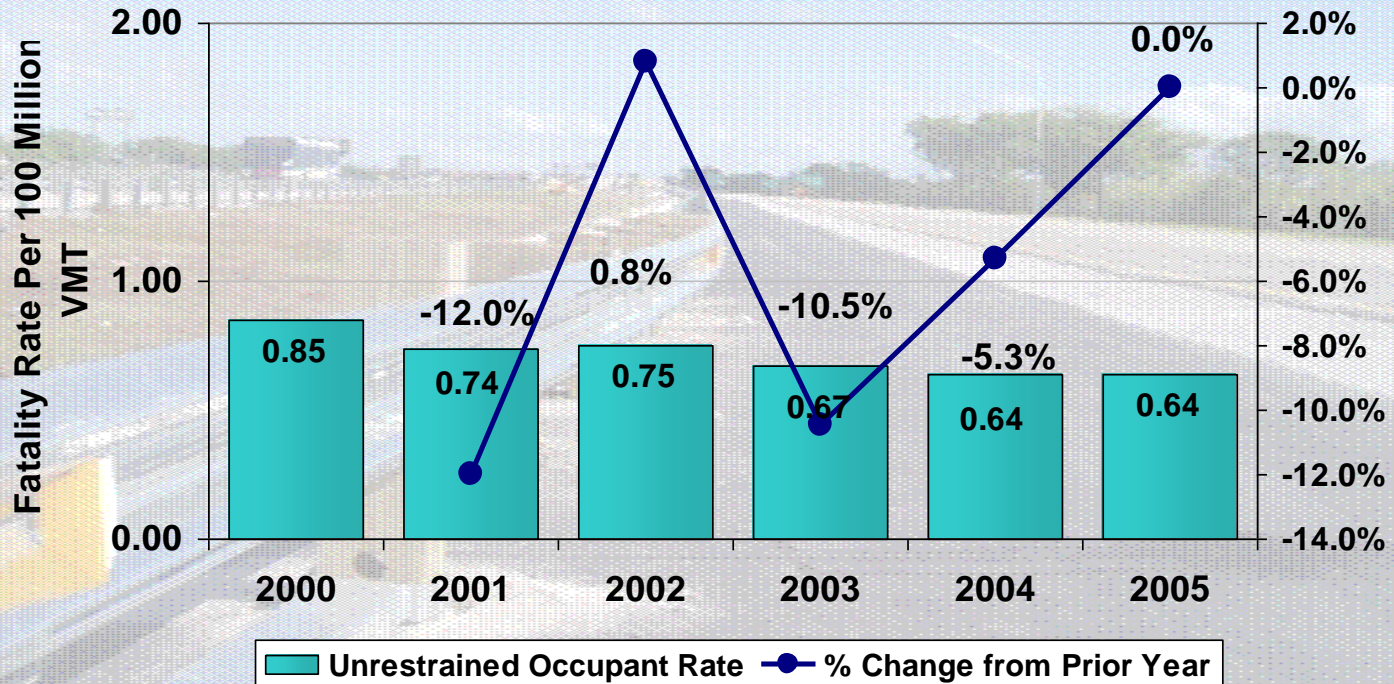
Florida's Car and Truck Unrestrained Fatality Rate Compared to Florida's All Occupant Rate

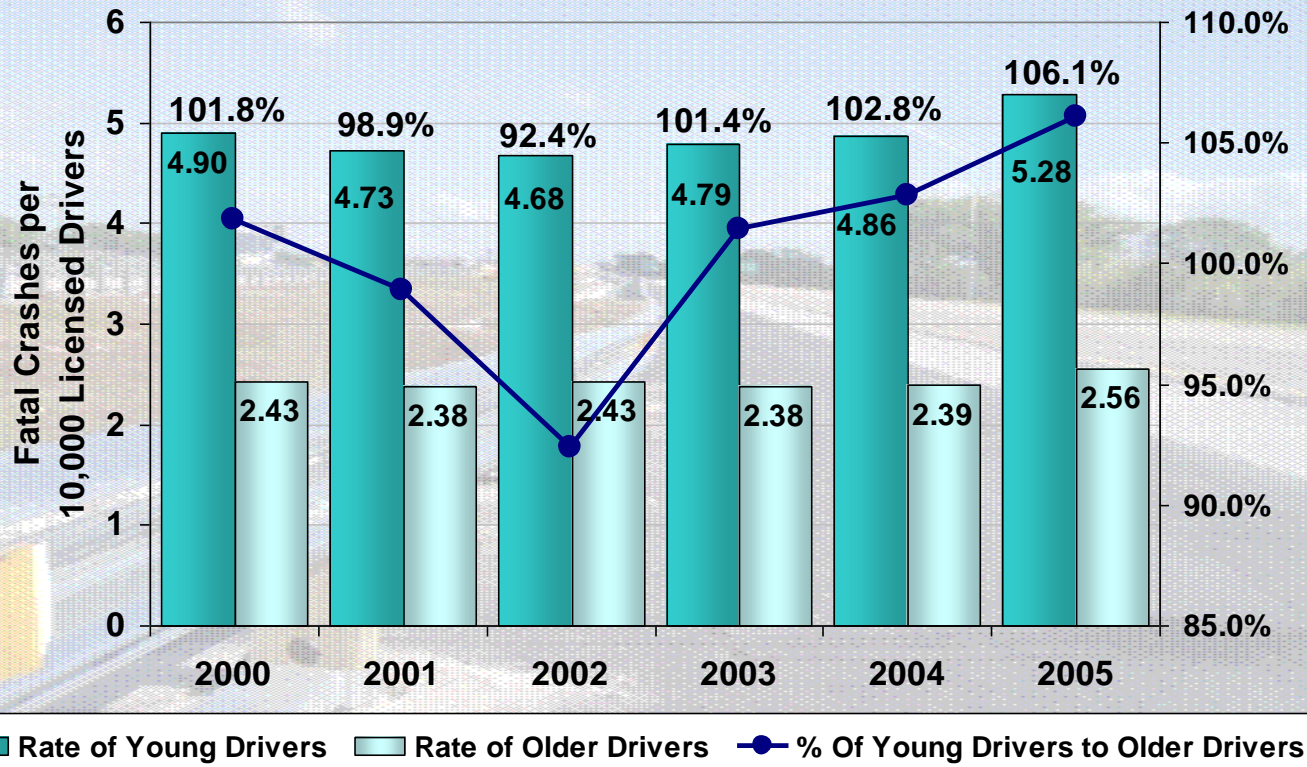
Florida Unrestrained Occupant Fatality Rate Change From Prior Year





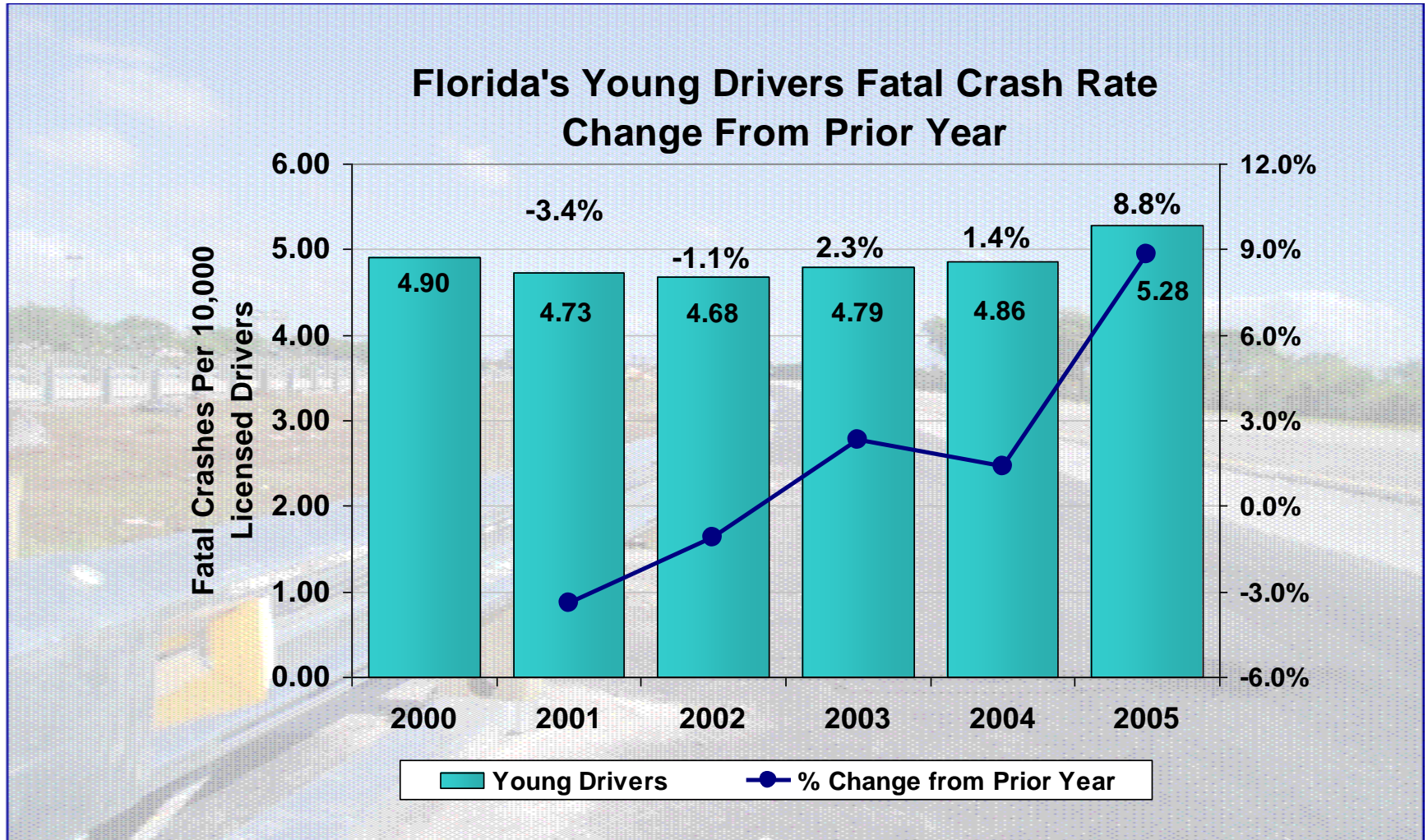

Florida's Fatal Crash Rate of Young Drivers (under age 25) Compared to Older Drivers (age 25 and over)



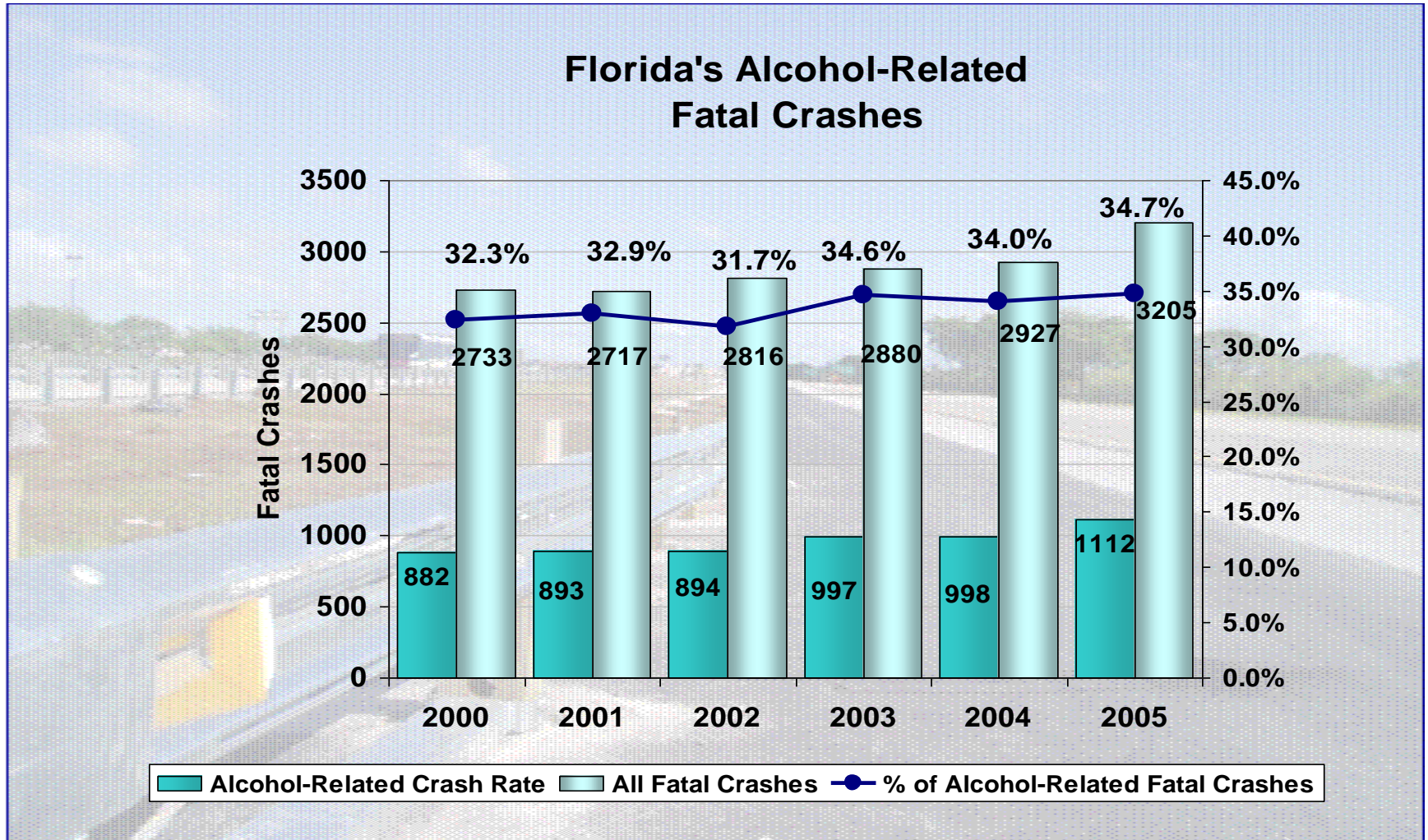

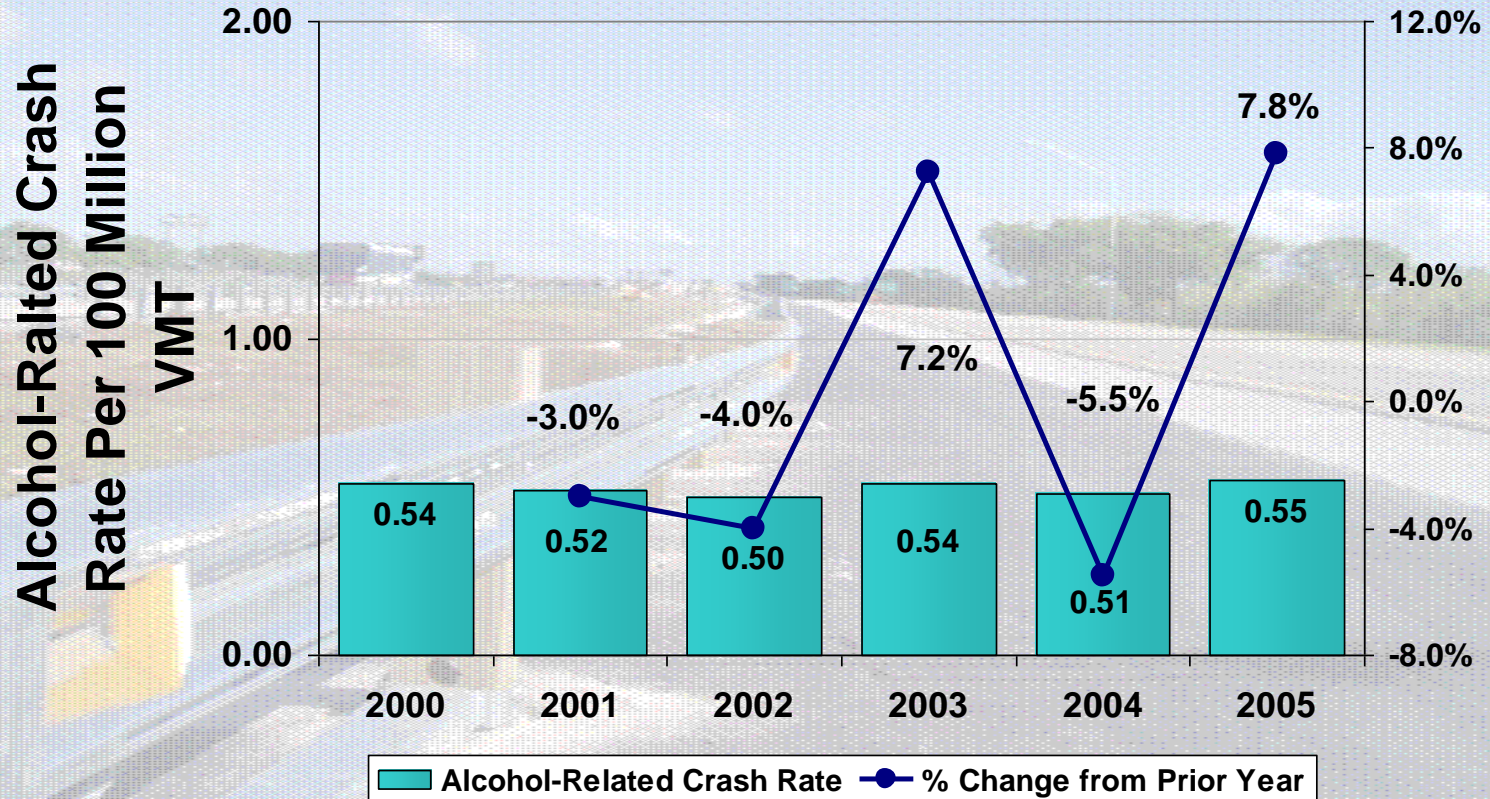
