


Local Sales Tax Extension

- Blueprint program philosophy in harmony with State goals




Public - Public Partnerships for Transportation

15 year local tax to generate	\$800 million	
Environmental Projects	\$77.0 million	10%
Stormwater and Recreational Projects	\$202.2 million	25%
Transportation Projects on State Road System	\$346.8 million	43%
Debt Service and City/County Allocation	\$174 million	22%


