**Florida Transportation Commission to Hold Meeting in Tallahassee, Florida
on Monday, March 3, 2014**

*-FDOT Secretary Ananth Prasad to give Response to FTC's review of the Tentative
Work Program-*

(Tallahassee, FL) The Florida Transportation Commission (FTC) will hold a meeting on Monday, March 3, 2014 from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. EST at the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in Tallahassee, Florida. At the meeting, the FTC will hold the Statewide Public Hearing on FDOT's Tentative Work Program for fiscal years 2014-2019 which directs the next five years of preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition, construction, public transportation projects and Turnpike and Rail Enterprise plans in the state of Florida.

The FTC will present their review of the Tentative Work Program, and receive a response and agency report from FDOT Secretary Ananth Prasad. Additionally, the Commission will hear presentations from District Secretaries and the Directors of the Turnpike and Rail Enterprise, as well as information on the fuel tax and the Small Business Development Initiative.
