Meeting

Attendance:

Call to Order and Chairman's Opening Remarks:

Chairman Howse called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM CT.

Commission Business Discussed:

- The Commission unanimously approved the meeting minutes from the October 17 conference call on a motion by Commissioner Burke and seconded by Commissioner Davis.
- Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Secretary Kevin J. Thibault provided an agency update.
- Ralph Yoder, Executive Director of the Florida Transportation Commission gave a detailed, but brief review of the Florida Department of Transportation's FY 2018/19 Performance and Production Review.
- Chairman Howse invited Secretary Thibault to respond to the Performance and Production Review, addressing the performance measures which the Department did not meet.
- District Secretaries, as well as the Executive Director of the Florida Turnpike Enterprise, presented updates on projects and construction in their areas and answered questions from the members regarding their respective districts.
- The Commission unanimously approved the Performance and Production review on a motion by Commissioner Davis and seconded by Commissioner Genson.
- Currently, there are 17 Primary performance measures and 18 Secondary measures. The performance measures were originally adopted by the Commission in December 1991.
- The Commission will once again review the performance metrics, since it has been several years since the metrics have been reviewed and updated.
