### **Call to Order and Chairman's Opening Remarks:**

#### **Commission Business Discussed:**

- The Commission approved the meeting minutes from the April 2<sup>nd</sup> conference call. The motion was made by Vice-Chairman Trumbull and seconded by Commissioner Burke. The motion passed unanimously.
- Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Chief of Staff Torey Alston provided an agency update on behalf of the department.
  - On April 10, 2020 Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-103, which extended Executive Oder 20-87 through April 30, 2020.
  - On April 14, 2020 Secretary Thibault facilitated the Program Planning Workshop. The workshop was held via webinar.
  - Weekly calls are being conducted with public use airports and all seaports.
  - Florida Airports received over \$800 million in funding from the CARES Act grant.
  - Critical infrastructure projects are being accelerated while there is reduced traffic.
- Executive Director Yoder stated that Florida Transportation Commission staff are still working a modified schedule.
- The Florida Transportation Commission Performance and Production Metrics Review Kickoff Meeting is scheduled for April 23, 2020. The meeting will be held via conference call and webinar.
- On April 21, 2020, the FDOT Planning office is hosting a Transportation Planning Exchange (TransPlex) webinar.
