- Staff with Carr, Riggs & Ingram updated the Commission on the progress made on deliverables, including the Performance and Production Review and the Review of Tentative Work Program.
- Chairman Howse reminded the Commission of the need to recruit potential candidates to fill current vacancies on the Florida Transportation Commission (FTC).
- Logistics regarding the FTC Retreat in June and 2019 Transportation Summer Camp in July were discussed.
- Commissioner Kigel provided an overview from the recent ITS World Congress Board Meeting in Los Angeles.
