


FTE & OTHER TOLLED SYSTEMS MAP

HISTORICAL TRUCK TRAFFIC






- Pledge of System (Statewide) Revenues


PROPOSED NEW MEASURES


- New focus
 - Net Income: Maximize infrastructure reinvestment
 - Revenue/expense management
 - Customer: Affordable tolls
 - Ensure ridership/commerce
- Derived from audited financial reports
 - Toll revenue
 - Net Income
 - Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT)
- Comparable (internal and external)

PROPOSED NEW MEASURES

System Transportation Asset Management (STAR) measures resources available for reinvestment after expenses.

Affordability Index is a measure of toll revenue to annual vehicle miles traveled.
