


2011 Jobless Claims: Declining








2011 Net Business Relocations: Positive




2011 Net Migration: Increasing







2011 Personal Income: Increasing








2011 Employer Expectations: Looking Up



- Recommend strategies to pursue most attractive opportunities






Why Focus on Trade? U.S. Foreign Trade Value Expected to Quadruple by 2035
