History of *User Pays Policy* in Oregon

- Nation's first gas tax enacted in 1919
- Nation's first weight mile tax for heavy vehicles enacted in 1933
- Nation's first cost allocation study completed in 1937



- Gas tax increases in 1921, 1923, 1930, 1933, 1949, 1967, 1982, 1984, 1985, 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993 and 2011



Initial Legislation Road User Fee Task Force

House Bill 3456 (2001)

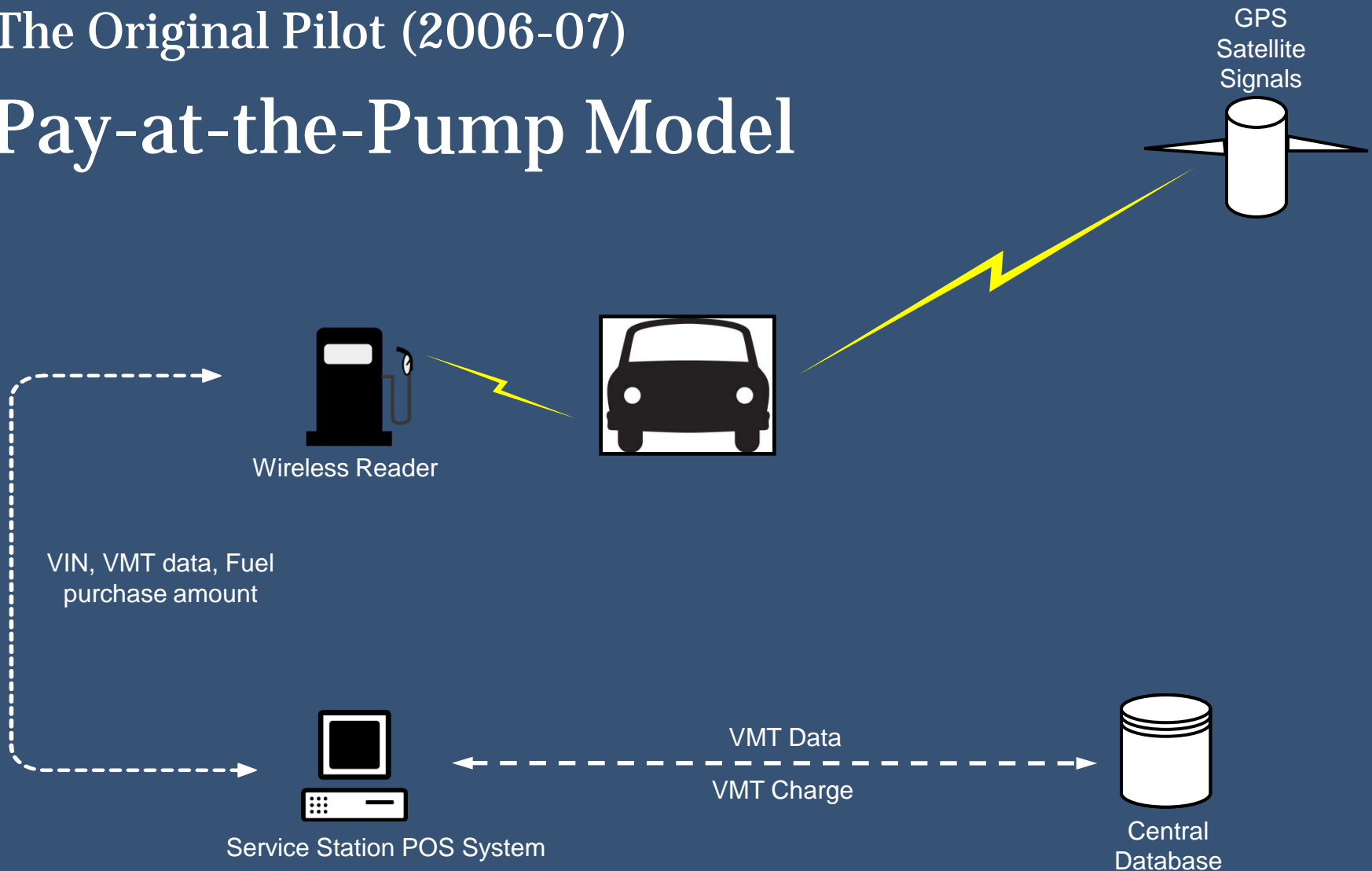


- Develop policy recommendations for new revenue system based on road use to replace current system
- Directs DOT to administer RUFTF
- Directs DOT to develop and implement pilot programs based on RUFTF policy recommendations
- Allows for fuel tax refund for pilot participants paying mileage fee

Pay-at-the-Pump Model



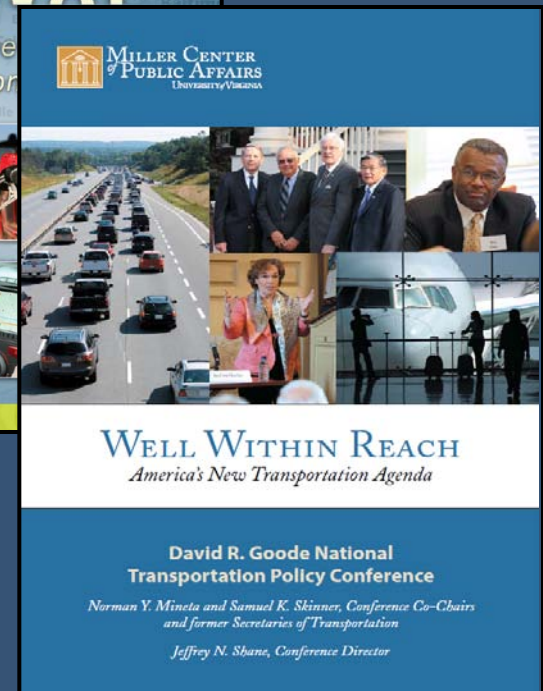
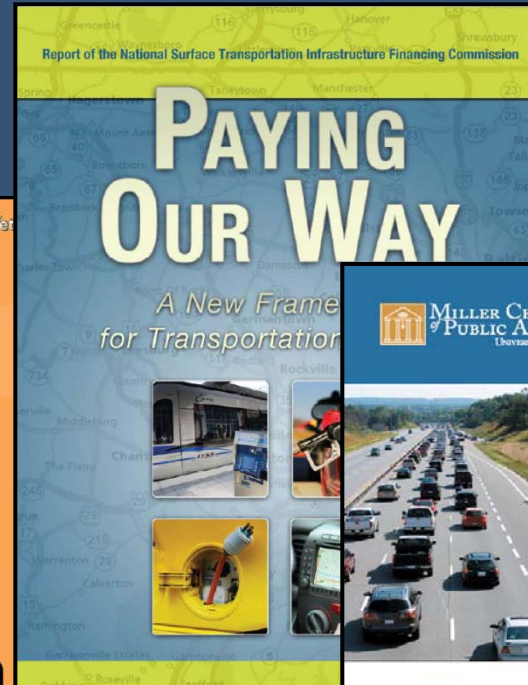
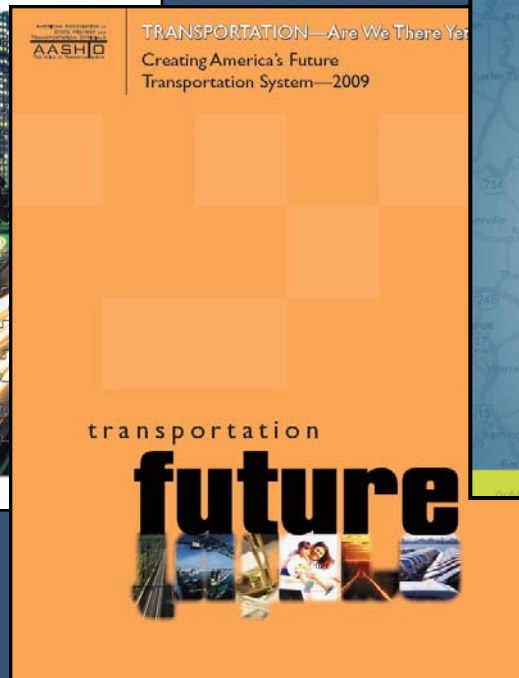
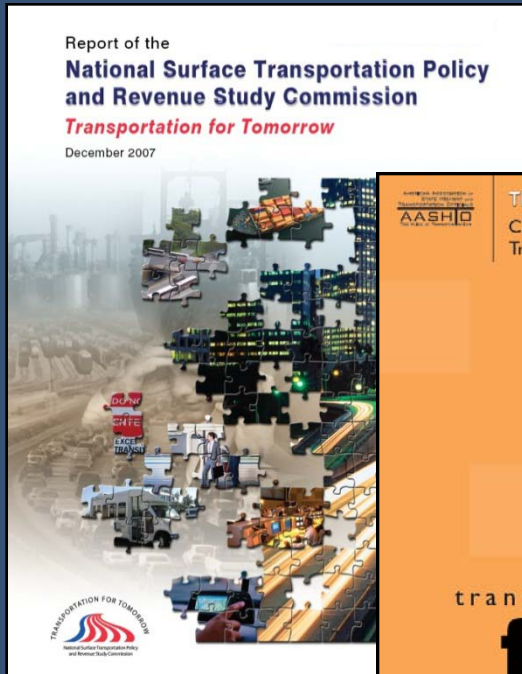

Operational Objectives for New Version of Per-Mile Road Usage Charge System

1. Choices for mileage reporting choices with no government mandated technologies
2. Access to open market for technologies
3. DOT & private sector administration options
4. Simple and easy for motorists



Three Categories of Mileage Reporting

1. Basic: Report all miles driven

- Manual reporting
- Electronic mileage reporting with no GPS

2. Advanced: Report miles by geographic location

- Electronic mileage reporting with GPS

3. Simplified: No reporting

- Assume maximum annual miles driven



Options for Electronic Mileage Reporting

1. Activate a metering device within vehicle
2. Install a metering device in vehicle

Oregon's Platform for a New Per-Mile Road Usage Charge System

- Based on machine to machine communications with a standard mileage message
- DOT certifies private sector entities to provide mileage reporting technologies under open system
- DOT certifies private sector entities as tax processing and account management alternatives to government
- Fully scalable, flexible and geographically unlimited

Standard Mileage Message Decoded

- Vehicle identification number
- Mileage reporting device identification number
- Timestamp for installations and removals of mileage reporting device
- Total mileage during reporting period
- Fuel consumption during reporting period
- For advanced plans, coordinates of mileage traveled





Oregon's Second Pilot Road Usage Charge Pilot Program

- November 1, 2012 to February 28, 2013
- 44 volunteer participants from Oregon
 - 8 state legislators
 - Others with policy interest
- Paid road usage charge, received fuel tax credit
- Private sector firms provide
 - Mileage reporting technologies
 - Tax processing and account management
- Washington DOT and Nevada DOT managed 44 additional participants

Oregon Road Usage Charge Legislation (SB 810)

- For 5,000 volunteer light vehicles
- Rate of 1.5 cents per mile
- Rebate of fuel tax paid
- ODOT develops methods of reporting
- Mandates choices for motorists
- At least one reporting choice must not use GPS
- Open market for reporting technologies
- Private sector administration option
- Penalties for false statements, non-payment and tampering
- Protection of personally identifiable information





Privacy Solutions

- Choices of Reporting Method and Provider
 - Basic reporting from odometer
 - Advanced reporting using vehicle location technology
 - Simplified reporting of assumed maximum miles driven
- Selection of Mileage Reporting Device from Marketplace
- Protection of Personally Identifiable Information
 - Limits who has access to PII
 - Imposes obligation to protect PII
 - Destroy mileage data within 30 days after later of
 - Payment processing
 - Dispute resolution
 - Noncompliance investigation

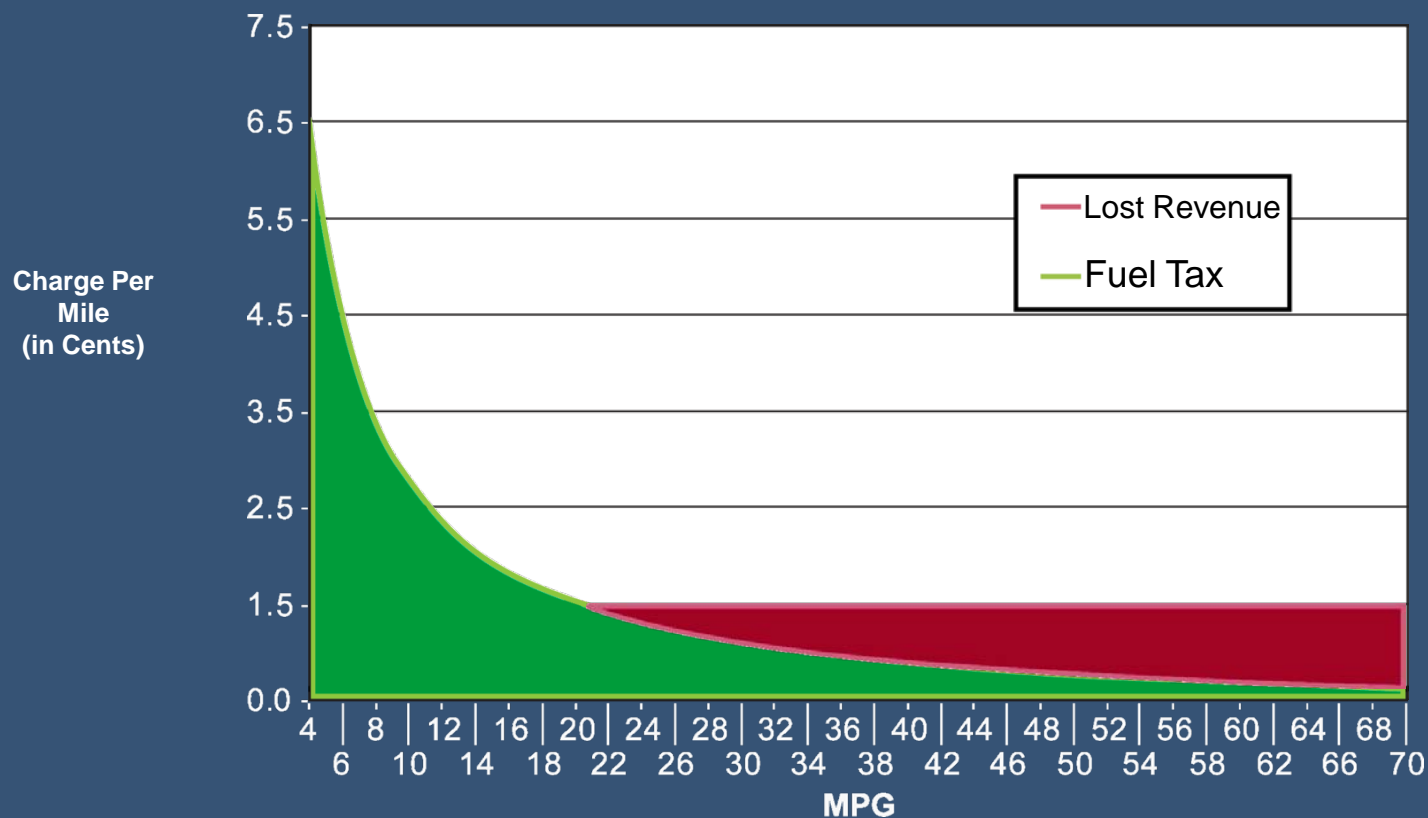


Rate Structure Issues for a Mandatory Road Usage Charge System

- Single Rate vs. Multiple Rates
- Complete Policy vs. Multiple Steps

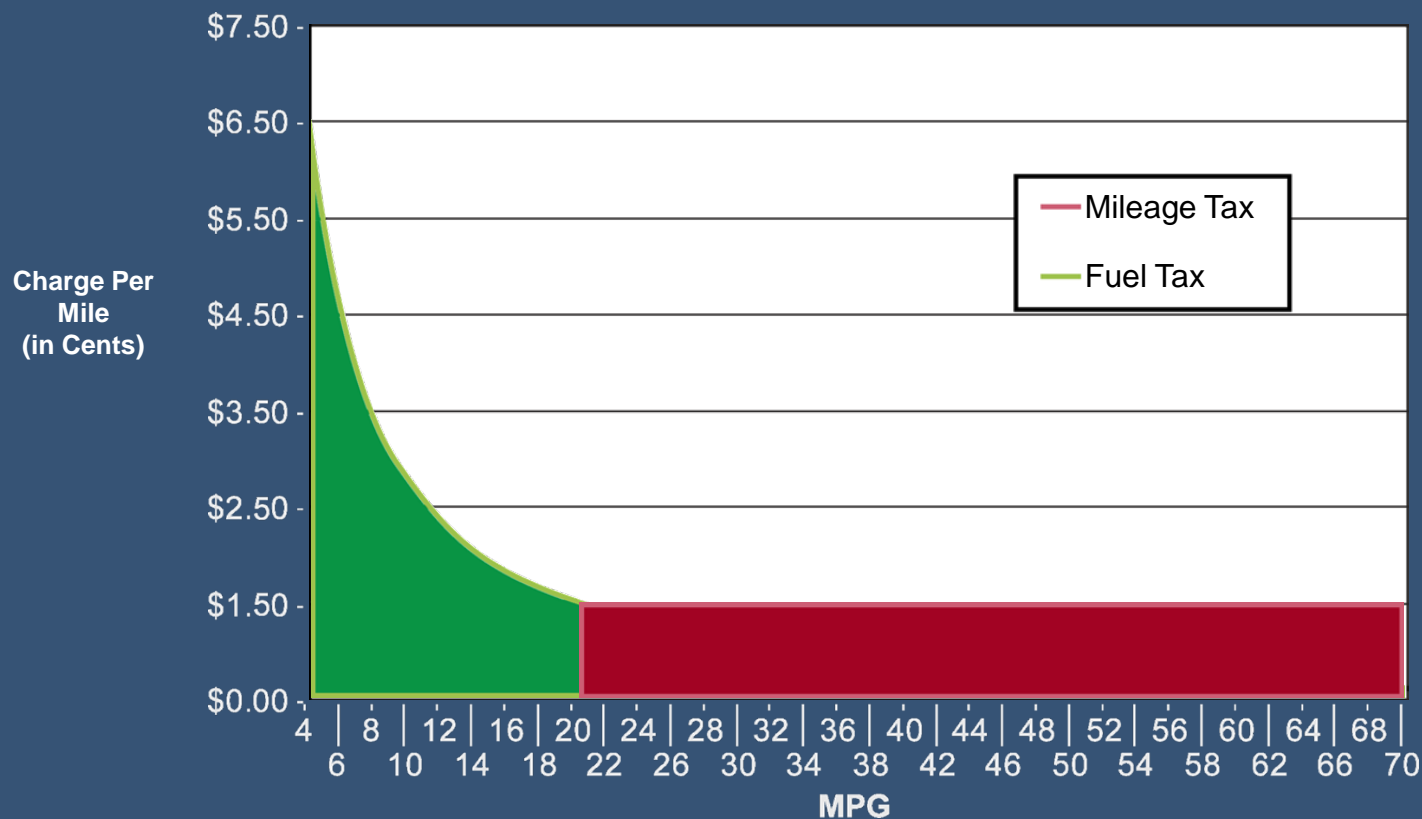


Fuel Tax Revenues and Lost Revenues



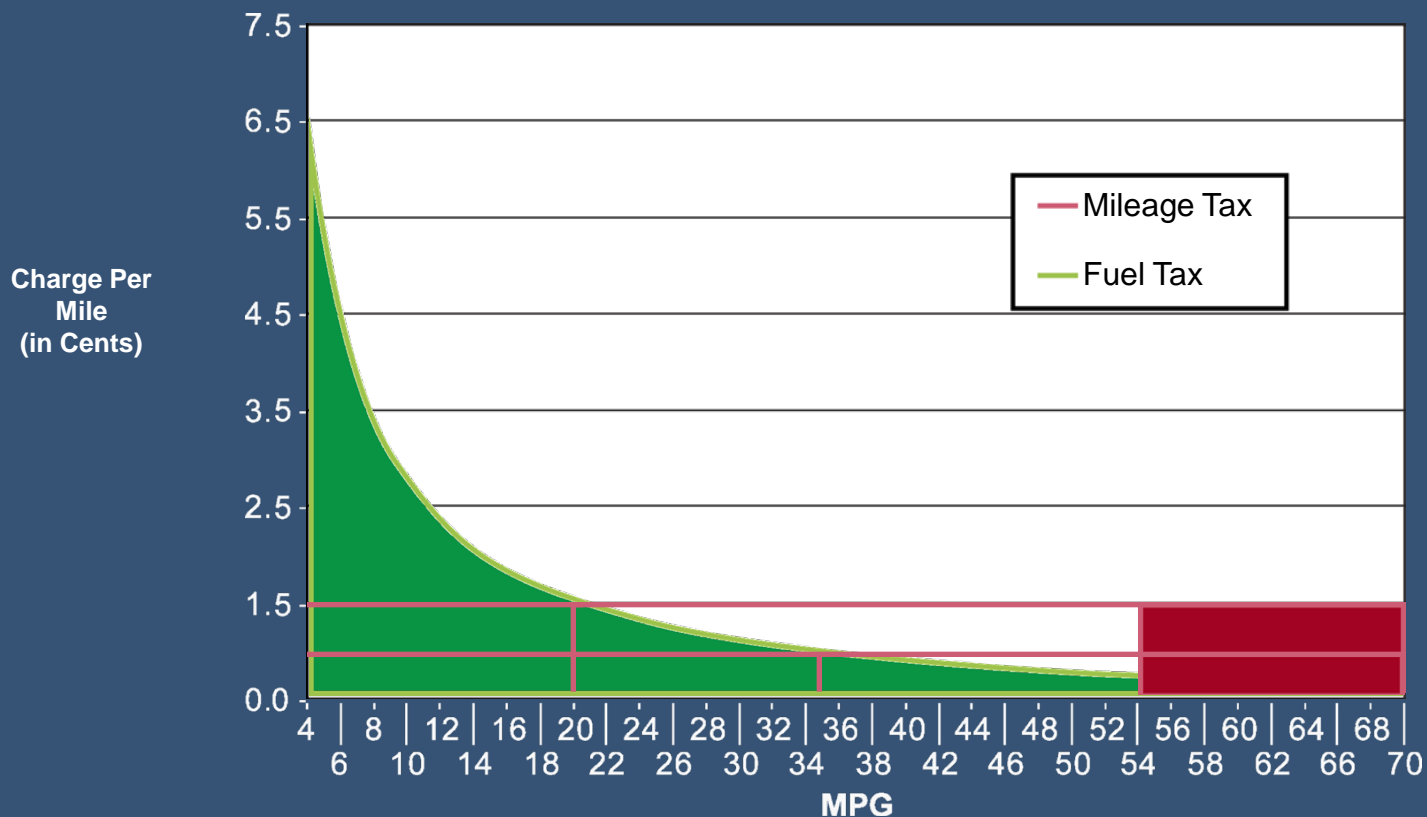


End Game for the Road Usage Charge?



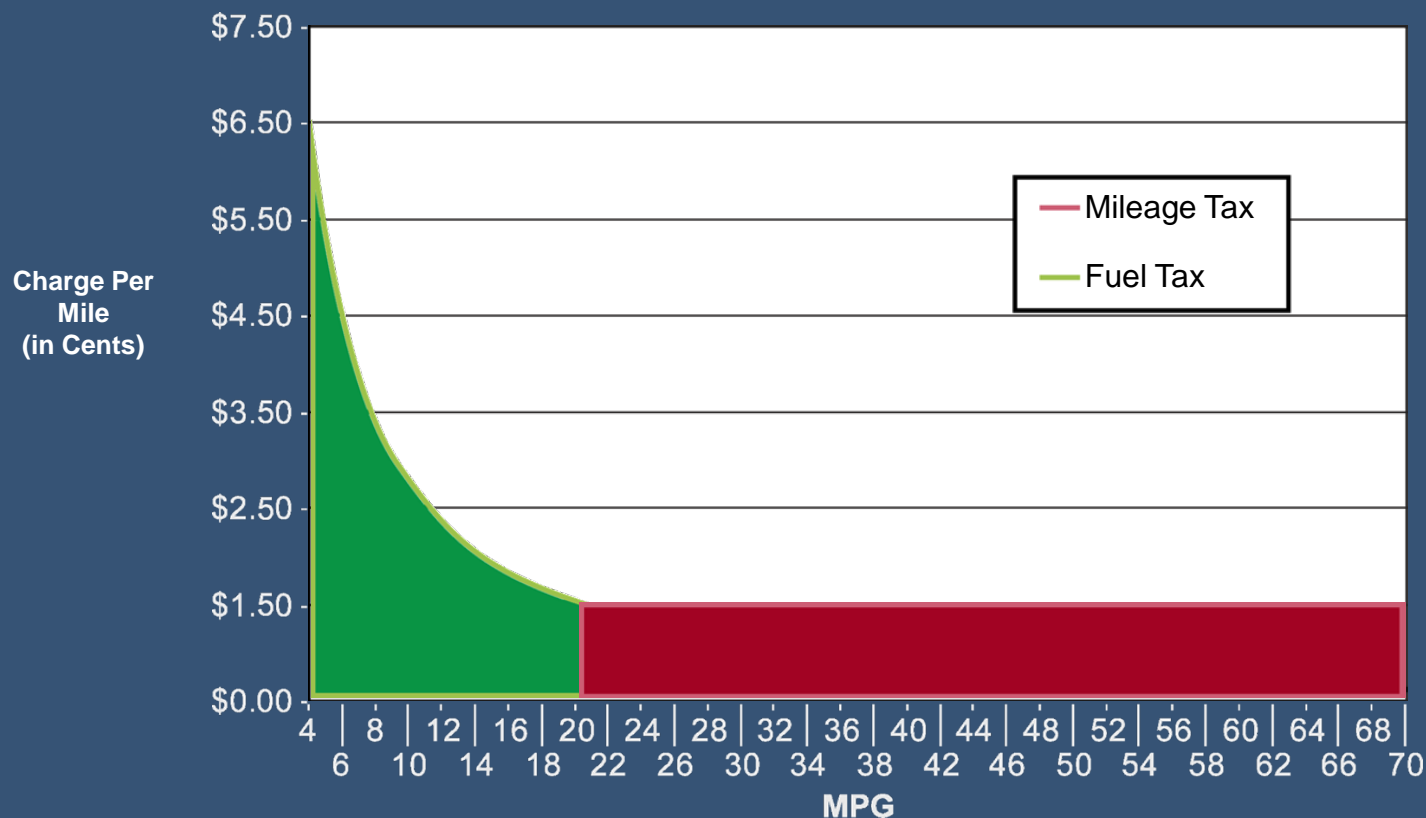


Start of the Road Usage Charge
